#### **Change in Procedures**

As many of you are aware, the building to the north of us has blocked their driveways and that has had a significant impact on our drop off and dismissal procedures. We have established our drop off and pick up procedures the way we have with student safety as our number one priority. I ask that you please follow our procedures and STRONGLY request that you refrain from dropping students off and picking them up along 25<sup>th</sup> Dr. When cars pull off to the curb, it slows the flow of traffic, often impedes cars from passing and creates a very dangerous environ-

ment for pedestrians. Many cars just "stick their nose" into an empty space along the curb and stop all traffic behind them. We have also been contacted by our neighbors across the street and informed that parents are parking their cars in the community driveway to their property. Please be respectful of each other and our neighbors. Please also note that we have been informed that law enforcement has been notified, and we should expect their presence to ensure that everyone is adhering to city traffic laws. We once again, encourage parents to use our drive thru student drop off and pick up line. You can drop your children off as early as 7:30 a.m. free of charge to avoid the traffic and the 3:15 p.m. pick up line is a quick and safe way to pick up students. We are through the entire line by 3:28 p.m. on most days.

### Quick Reminders:

Follow all state/city traffic laws.

Do not cut in front of cars that are waiting in the drive thru pick up line. We ask that you join the line by coming in off of 25<sup>th</sup> Dr. and then Banff.

Have your school issued placard displayed in your windshield.

Do not speed through the parking lot, especially during drop off and pick up times.

Make sure you communicate with your child where you will be picking them up.

Enter off of Banff Dr. and Exit onto 25<sup>th</sup> Dr. Please DO NOT enter the campus through the exit.

The round-about in front of the office is for disabled and emergency vehicle parking only. Please do not drop off or pick up kids in the round-about.

If you are on campus to visit or to pick up a child, you will be required to have the school issued pink placard, parent badge, or a visitor badge from the front office.
