# Open Enrollment for 2023-2024 School Year

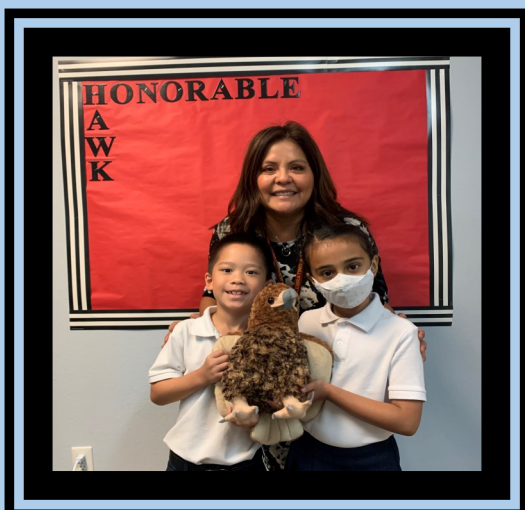
If you have a kindergartener for next year, siblings receive admissions preference, but we need to have an application so we know to save their seat. If you have other children in any grade you'd like to enroll at Painted Rock Academy please apply during Open Enrollment.

Kindergarteners must be five years old on August 31, 2024, to attend during the 2024-2025 school year. After November 19<sup>th</sup>, any remaining openings are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, so encourage your friends to apply soon.

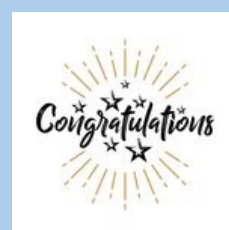
