From the Principal's Desk

Dear PRA Families,

We have officially reached the half-way point of the 2023-24 school year. While I am very pleased with the progress we've made this semester, there is always room for improvement. One very important area in need of improvement is attendance.

Please reference your student handbook to read Reid Traditional Schools' policy on tardies, but note that, "A student who has accumulated four (4) unexcused tardies in a quarter will be assigned a detention. If the student receives a fifth unexcused tardy in a quarter, the student and parent may be required to have a conference with an administrator... continued tardies may result in an in-school suspension, and further tardies will lead to out-of-school suspensions." Painted Rock Academy will enforce this policy.

At PRA, our school day begins at 8:00 a.m. As principal, I expect my teachers to begin teaching at 8:00am. Each and every teacher on campus has a written plan for beginning of the day procedures to ensure that learning begins promptly at 8:00. In order for this plan to be as effective as possible, students must be on time in the morning. When students are entering the classroom late, it distracts the students who are working and prevents the teacher from most effectively planning instructional activities for that period of the day.

I also want to take just a moment to remind you of the importance of establishing a routine with your children. Often the third quarter of the school year is a very difficult quarter academically, as the curriculum becomes even more challenging. Having a set routine will benefit them academically and help you stay on top of their studies and homework. I encourage you to set aside a specific time daily for your children to complete their homework and studies in a well-lit, quiet area where they are free from distractions. It is also important to read and practice math facts daily with your children to reinforce these foundational skills. Painted Rock Academy is committed to the educational success of all of our students, and we again thank you for including us in your child's journey.

Lastly, I want to remind you to continue to drive safely while on and around campus. Our school parking lot/pick-up lines are all one-way traffic. All vehicles enter the school parking lot on West Banff Lane and exit the school parking lot onto N. 25th Drive. This applies for any time of the day, before, during or after school. If you're in our pick-up line, please be sure to make sure it is clear to your left to leave the pick-up line prior to pulling your vehicle away from the curb. Also remember it is a school parking lot full of pedestrians, so please drive cautiously. Most of all, please be patient.
